UWOFA's website acts as an important point of contact for UWOFA members, the other Western constituencies, and the community at large. It is the responsibility of UWOFA's Communications Chair and the Communications Officer to maintain an updated website subject to the provisions below:

1. Collective agreements shall remain on the website throughout the life of the contract.
2. The content of *UWOFA Matters* and *Beyond the Gates* is the responsibility of the Communications Chair and President.
3. Substantive changes to the website must be approved by the President or designate. Minor corrections or updates may be made on the authority of the UWOFA staff.
